Salvador, Federative Republic of Brazil
16–17 June 2026

We, the participants of the World Public Summit. Latin America - representatives of civil society, expert, academic and business communities, international organizations and youth, gathered in the city of Salvador, Federative Republic of Brazil,

reaffirming our commitment to the principles of international humanitarian cooperation,

striving to preserve the unique spiritual heritage of the peoples of the world, while respecting the moral ideals and cultural values of every nation,

recognizing the special role of solidarity, social justice and respect for human dignity as integral values of the peoples of Latin America,

guided by the provisions of the Declaration of the First World Public Assembly “New World of Conscious Unity”,

proceeding from the understanding of the growing role of joint efforts by the international community in promoting a new world order based on sovereign equality,

noting that the contemporary idea of multipolarity represents a new framework in which partnership and cooperation among nations require a deeper level of trust,

hereby adopt this Declaration and state the following:

1. VALUES OF THE NEW WORLD

We reaffirm that a just and sustainable world order is based on:

— the preservation and further development of cultural diversity as a key factor of humanity’s stable development;

— the sovereign equality of states and peoples;

— the conscious unity of peoples as custodians of enduring spiritual values;

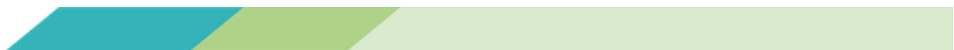
— the primacy of dialogue, trust and mutual respect;

— the preservation of historical memory and traditional values;

— responsibility toward future generations.

We are convinced that sustainable development can be achieved only through cooperation and coordinated efforts.

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2. VISION OF A SHARED FUTURE

We view the emerging New World as a space for:

- searching for the Meanings of the future, creating better opportunities for the development of nations and peoples;
- a new style of international relations that simultaneously considers national and global interests;
- a harmonious combination of traditions and modern technologies;
- open and equal dialogue among cultures and civilizations;
- humanitarian cooperation as the foundation of sustainable development.

We proceed from the understanding that the highest value of the future is the human person, whose rights, freedoms and dignity constitute the basis of just social development.

3. ROLE OF LATIN AMERICA

We recognize Latin America as an important center of the emerging multipolar world.

The region's experience, grounded in the pursuit of social justice, solidarity and the protection of national sovereignty, shapes its distinctive role in the contemporary world.

The region possesses significant historical, cultural and social potential and is capable of:

- actively contributing to the formation of the global humanitarian agenda;
- strengthening trust and mutual understanding among peoples;
- developing sustainable models of cooperation and partnership;
- contributing to shaping a more just system of international relations.

4. PHILOSOPHY OF THE “NEW WORLD”

We reaffirm our commitment to the concept of the “New World of Conscious Unity” as the foundation for building a just system of international relations based on:

- a community of partners as the most effective form of self-organization of the world community;
- strengthening the role of public diplomacy;
- fostering a culture of trust and mutual understanding;
- respecting differences while seeking common solutions.

We believe that unity is achieved through dialogue rather than through uniformity.

5. PRIORITY AREAS OF COOPERATION

For the implementation of this Declaration, we identify the following priorities:

- the development of international humanitarian and educational projects;
- the formation of value-based guidelines for younger generations;
- support for youth initiatives and leadership;
- the expansion of cultural exchange and intercivilizational dialogue;
- the development of cooperation in science, technology and media;
- strengthening cooperation among civil society institutions through the effective use of people-to-people diplomacy and mechanisms of business, scientific, educational and humanitarian cooperation;
- expanding opportunities for every individual to realize their potential and contribute constructively to common development.

6. COMMITMENT AND RESPONSIBILITY

We express our readiness to:

- support processes of social unity and cooperation at the public level;
- strengthen partnerships among countries and regions;
- support initiatives aimed at fostering an atmosphere of trust;
- participate in the implementation of joint international projects;
- contribute to the formation of the global humanitarian agenda.

This Declaration reflects the shared aspiration of the participants to promote a just, sustainable and harmonious world based on the principles of solidarity, trust, mutual respect and shared responsibility for our common future.
