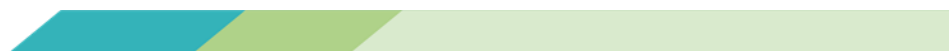

“New World: Latin America in Shaping a Shared Future”

Salvador, Federative Republic of Brazil
16–17 June 2026

We, the participants of the World Public Summit. Latin America “New World: Latin America in Shaping a Shared Future” - representatives of civil society, expert, academic and business communities, international organizations and youth, gathered in Salvador, Federative Republic of Brazil,

taking into account the outcomes of the plenary sessions, thematic discussions, expert meetings and consultations held within the framework of the Summit;

reaffirming our commitment to the development of international humanitarian cooperation, public diplomacy and sustainable partnerships;

guided by the values of solidarity, social justice, respect for cultural diversity and human dignity;

hereby adopt this Resolution and agree on the following:

1. To adopt the Salvador (Brazil) Declaration

as the principal outcome document of the World Public Summit. Latin America “New World: Latin America in Shaping a Shared Future”, reflecting the shared vision, values and principles of cooperation among the Summit participants.

2. In furtherance of the provisions of the Salvador (Brazil) Declaration,

the participants of the Summit identify the following priority areas of international humanitarian, educational, cultural and public cooperation:

2.1. Development of Public Diplomacy

- expanding networks of cooperation among civil society institutions of Latin America and other regions of the world;

- supporting initiatives aimed at strengthening trust and mutual understanding among peoples;

- promoting direct people-to-people interaction as a key element of international cooperation.

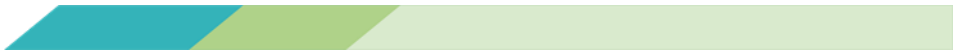
2.2. Support for Youth and Leadership

- creating international platforms aimed at fostering youth leadership;

- supporting exchange, education and international cooperation programmes for young people;

- engaging younger generations in shaping the global humanitarian agenda.

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2.3. Humanitarian and Educational Cooperation

- developing joint educational and scientific projects;
- supporting cooperation among universities and research institutions;
- promoting wider access to education and the development of human potential.

2.4. Cultural Interaction and Preservation of Identity

- promoting cultural exchange and intercivilizational dialogue;
- supporting initiatives aimed at preserving historical memory and cultural heritage;
- strengthening respect for the cultural identity of peoples.

2.5. Economic Cooperation and Social Development

- facilitating partnership-based economic initiatives;
- supporting socially oriented development models;
- strengthening interaction between business and humanitarian initiatives.

2.6. Technology and Information Environment

- promoting cooperation in science, technology, and innovation;
- supporting the development of a secure information environment;
- facilitating digital sovereignty and broader access to technology.

2.7. Media and Global Dialogue

- strengthening the role of the media as an instrument of public diplomacy;
- supporting the development of a responsible media environment;
- promoting international communication platforms.

2.8. Strengthening International Cooperation

- developing cooperation within BRICS, regional integration associations, and other international cooperation frameworks;
- supporting the formation of a fair and multipolar system of international relations;
- strengthening trust and partnership among countries and regions.

3. Support and Implementation of Summit Initiatives

- ensuring the implementation of initiatives developed within the framework of the Summit;
- promoting international humanitarian, educational, and cultural projects;
- supporting the development of long-term partnerships and cooperation agreements.

4. Proposals for the Second World Public Assembly 2026

The participants of the Summit propose that the following initiatives be considered at the Second World Public Assembly “New World: Values that Unite”:

- promotion of the principle of solidarity as a foundation of international cooperation;
- development and advancement of a Global Public Platform for Cooperation and Public Diplomacy;
- establishment of an International Network for Youth Leadership and Public Initiatives;
- expansion of programmes for cultural dialogue and preservation of identity;
- support for initiatives in education, science and technology;
- development of a responsible global media environment;
- promotion of partnership-based economic models and socially oriented development.

5. Further Steps

- ensuring coordination of the implementation of the provisions of this Resolution;
- continuing the development of the network of World Public Summits in various regions of the world;
- considering the outcomes of the Summit in shaping the global humanitarian agenda;
- considering the outcomes of the Summit in preparation for the Second World Public Assembly “New World: Values that Unite” in Moscow.

This Resolution is aimed at implementing the provisions of the Salvador (Brazil) Declaration, promoting practical cooperation among peoples, civil society institutions and expert communities of Latin America and other regions of the world, and reflects the common aspiration of the participants to advance cooperation based on the principles of solidarity, trust, mutual respect and shared responsibility for our common future.
